

Programme Entrance Requirements

1. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Chinese

Applicants should have obtained a Grade E or above in AL Chinese Literature or Chinese History or a Grade D or above in AS Chinese Language and Culture*.

2. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Contemporary English Studies

Applicants should have obtained a Grade D or above in AS Use of English. Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained a Grade E or above in AL/AS Literature in English.

3. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Cultural Studies

Applicants should have obtained a Grade D or above in AS Use of English and Chinese Language and Culture*. Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained a Grade E or above in AL/AS subjects such as History, Literature or Liberal Studies.

4. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in History

Applicants should have obtained a Grade D or above in AS Use of English and Chinese Language and Culture. Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained a Grade E or above in AL/AS History or Chinese History.

5. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Philosophy

Same as General Entrance Requirements. Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained a Grade D or above in AS Chinese Language and Culture, Ethics and Religious Studies or Liberal Studies.

6. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Translation

Applicants should have obtained a Grade D or above in AS Use of English.

7. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Visual Studies

Same as General Entrance Requirements. Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained a Grade E or above in AL/AS Visual Arts or AS Liberal Studies. In addition, applicants' Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE) results may be taken into consideration.

8. Bachelor of Business Administration (Honours)

Same as General Entrance Requirements.

9. Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours)

Same as General Entrance Requirements.

Notes:

Passes in AL and AS subjects can be obtained at one or more sittings. The best grade for a subject will be used in the calculation of the score in case of multiple attempts. There is no penalty or marks deducted for repeated sittings of a subject.

* Or Grade C or above in the alternative Chinese language qualifications of IGCSE/GCSE/GCE O-Level.
