

Liu Lit Mo Overseas Student Scholarships

Notes for Applicants

1. Background of the Scholarships

The scholarships were established in 2005/06, with generous donation from Dr. Liu Lit Mo, MBE, JP.

Scholarships of HK\$100,000 each per academic year will be awarded to successful applicants, covering tuition fee, hostel and other academic and living expenses. Each scholarship is offered on an annual renewable basis and is tenable for a period up to 3 years, subject to continued outstanding academic performance. In 2007-08, the annual tuition fee is HK\$60,000 and the hostel fee is HK\$8,900 per year. Fees for 2008-09 are under review.

2. Eligibility

- An overseas student who wishes to pursue an undergraduate programme at Lingnan University from September 2008 on a full-time basis leading to an honours degree may apply for the scholarship.
- Students who have completed or are studying for a curriculum relevant to the programme(s) for which they are applying for may apply for credit transfer. In Hong Kong, students follow a 7-year secondary education system and then a bachelor's degree which normally requires three years of academic study.
- Students who have satisfactorily completed the 1st or 2nd year of a 4-year undergraduate curriculum may be admitted to the 1st or 2nd year of a Lingnan programme.
- Students may be required to gain a minimum of Grade C in English in the GCE O-Level or GCSE Examination or an equivalent public examination; or a TOEFL score of 213 in the computer-based test, or 550 in the paper-based test, or 79 in the internet-based test; or an IELTS overall band score of 5.5.

3. Selection Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded to a student who has good academic standing and a good track record in community services. For candidates of comparable academic merits, the scholarship will be awarded to the candidate with better proven records of community services.

4. Application Procedures

The application period for both admissions and scholarships is normally from **15 December 2007 to 31 March 2008**.

For **paper-form** application, please submit the completed Scholarship Application Form with your Application for Admission form (both available at www.LN.edu.hk/admissions/da/intl), together with other supporting documents by post to: ***The Registry, Lingnan University, 8 Castle Peak Road, Tuen Mun, Hong Kong***. For **online** application, please upload and submit the completed form and relevant documents through the online application system. In your application, please include a reference letter(s) issued by your school principal and/or academic referee.

Applicants for the scholarships can apply for admission to all programmes offered by Lingnan University, except Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in Contemporary English and Education, which is a four-year programme offered jointly by Lingnan University and the Hong Kong Institute of Education.
