# **Brief Course Description:**

This course introduces students to the study of Chinese myths. Major themes, motifs and structure of myths would be dealt with in classes.

#### Aims:

This course offers an introduction to mythic themes in literature, acquainting students with the concept of myth and the position mythology occupies in the realm of literature. The course aims at familiarizing students with theories and techniques in western mythology, especially the structural and psychoanalytic approaches.

## **Learning Outcomes:**

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. analyse different types of myths, such as creation myth, flood myth etc.;
- 2. compare different motifs such as narcissus etc.;
- 3. analyse different mythical structures;
- 4. apply the myths and mythical theories they have learnt in the studying of literary pieces.

9) Mythical Motif 神話母題

**Teaching Method:** 

2 hours of lecture and 1 hour of tutorial per week. The significance of original western

myths will be explained, while Chinese myths of a similar nature will be discussed
