1. Introduction

Current Lingnan students can access the "CTLE Access System for Students" to view CTLE results. A student who has taken a course or a students who intends to take a course can apply for approval to view the previous CTLE results (excluding written comments provided by students). The course offering unit will decide if a student's application will be granted. A student can apply to view the most current CTLE scores and those of the previous one year only.

A student can view CTLE results of courses with the level same as the student's level of study in Lingnan as of the time of submitting the application.

3. Apply for approval to view CTLE results

3.1 Search for courses

- **Maximum of six courses** can be submitted for **one application**. You can submit another application if more than six courses are to be requested.

- Enter searching word to search for courses. Searching results include all courses if the searching word in the "Search for Course(s)" field is found in any of course code, course title or instructor's name.
