General Eligibility

- Current full-time undergraduate student
- Year of Study: Year 2 or 3 on a 4-year programme
- CGPA: 2.50 or above as of Term 1, 2023-24

 Students with CGPA of 2.00-2.49 will also be considered on a case-by-case basis
- Any **additional requirements** for individual institutions as required by the host institution(s)

General Eligibility (Con't)

- NO previous in-person exchange experience of Student Exchange Programmes (SEP) and in-person Summer/Winter International Exchange Programmes arranged by OGE (except King's College London and The University of British Columbia programmes)
- Students participating in Summer Programmes 2024 WILL NOT be considered for other Student Exchange Programmes organized by OGE in the future (except King's College London and The University of British Columbia programmes).

Special Remarks on "Year 4" students

- Lingnan students are in principle **NOT** allowed to participate in exchange programmes in the **FINAL** TERM in the final year.
- If you are currently "Year 4" but you have confirmed that you have to graduate in Term 1, 2024-25 or later, you are eligible to apply for Summer Programmes 2024. You will need to submit a "Confirmation Form on Expected Graduation Year" as a supporting document. For details, please consult OGE and send us an email to obtain the form.

Budget

- Programme fee and miscellaneous fees of host institution
- Tax, security, fuel and miscellaneous surcharges of air ticket

Air Ticket Sponsorship

- Available for MOST <u>Summer Programmes</u>
- Net airfare sponsored by Lingnan
- Most economic and possible flight between Hong Kong and the host country within a designated period
- Tax, security, fuel and miscellaneous surcharges and extra cost for personal trips to be borne by students
- Purchase through the designated travel agency –
 Corporate Travel Management Ltd CTM

*Remark: Students enrolled in self-financed programmes should consult the respective programme offices/home departments on the funding availability and arrangements.

Scheme on Subsidy on Exchange for Post-secondary Students (SSE) and Scheme for Means-tested Subsidy on Exchange to "Belt and Road" Regions for Post-secondary Students (Means-tested SSEBR)

Local students participating in eligible Summer Programmes and receiving means-tested student financial assistance from Student Finance Office (SFO) of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency or whose families are in receipt of the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) are welcome to apply.

Eligible students may receive a subsidy up to a maximum of HK\$19,000.

Scheme for Non-means-tested Subsidy on Exchange to "Belt and Road" Regions for Post-Secondary Students (Non-means-tested SSEBR)

Local students participating in eligible Summer Programmes in <u>Belt and Road (B&R) regions (i.e. Korea, Italy, Lithuania, Czech Republic)</u> listed at the Hong Kong Trade Development Council website (excluding the Mainland, Taiwan and Macao) are welcome to apply.

Eligible students may receive a subsidy up to a maximum of HK\$5,400.

- Applications will be assessed based on
 - (1) the approved level of student finance (if applicable)
 - (2) destination of your exchange
 - (3) duration of your exchange
 - (4) availability of the fund

- Students with successful offers of eligible Summer Programmes will receive an email in March/April 2024.
- Eligible students should submit the duly completed online application form together with the copy of approval letter from Student Financial Office (SFO) (if applicable).
- Result will be announced around **July 2024**. You are advised to prepare your own money to finance your exchange.
- You must confirm accepting the EDB Subsidy on the online application system. The subsidy will be deposited into your bank account by **September 2024**.

Credit Transfer


- You should take the required no. of credits of your summer programme listed out in the Guidance Notes of Summer Programmes 2024.
- Transfer credits with prior approval from relevant dept. / programme/programme director
- The maximum study load in a summer term is **2 courses** or **6 credits**. Credits taken will be counted in the maximum study load for academic year of 2023-24 or in the next academic year (i.e. 2024-25) as appropriate
- Grades obtained will **NOT** be counted in GPA calculation, but the actual grades obtained will be shown in the transcript

Application Procedures

- Submit the online application by 10 a.m., 29 January 2024 (Monday)
- Go through course offerings, pre-requisites, syllabuses, assessments etc. carefully and choose programme(s) that you feel confident to succeed
- Choose 1-10 choices to maximize your chance in securing an offer
- TOEFL or IELTS test results are **OPTIONAL** (except for the additional English requirement(s) as required by the host institution(s))
- Attend group online selection interview conducted in English tentatively from 31 January - 1 February 2024
- Application results will be announced via e-mail in mid-February 2024.

What's Next after Successful Application?

- Upon receiving offer from OGE via e-mail, think twice and talk to your parents before accepting the offer
- 2. Attend the briefing session on 4 March 2024
- 3. Register and attend OSA Enhancement Programme according to e-mail from OSA (Details to be announced in due course)
- 4. Prepare application materials according to OGE e-mail
- 5. Upon successful admission by host institution, make necessary payment to your host institution (Details to be announced in due course)
- 6. Prepare visa (if necessary), purchase air tickets and insurance, complete study plan etc.
- 7. Complete study plan and seek endorsement from respective Lingnan authorities

Obligations of Participants of Summer Programmes

- Submit pre/post-exchange survey, essay(s) and photo(s) before and upon completion of exchange upon request
- Assist in promotional activities in student exchange programmes (e.g. making presentations to prospective outgoing students to share your exchange experience)
- Participating students are responsible for satisfactorily completing the programme. Failure to do so may result in the following:
 - → paying back any fees which are being sponsored by LU or the host institution;
 - → leading to negative impacts on future exchange and/or exchange scholarship applications.

*LU also reserves the right to review the programme subsidy (if any) after the end of the programme, based on student's successful completion of the programme and passing of all required assessments.

Obligations of Participants of Summer Programmes (Con't)


Extracted from Participation Agreement

- 8. Should I fail to complete my study as scheduled for whatever reason, I understand that all expenses spent/ to be paid in relation to the Exchange Programmes are my own responsibility and non-refundable in any case. I also undertake to pay back Lingnan University for any allowance/ sponsorships/ subsidies/ financial assistance/ scholarships granted and expenses paid on my behalf.
- 9. I shall, during my participation in the Exchange Programmes, meet the minimum academic standards, complete all coursework, prescribed tests and examinations (if any), and obtain satisfactory academic results as defined by Lingnan University and the host institution. I understand that, failure to complete the academic requirements at host institution may carry the same financial obligations as stated in clause 8 listed above.

Important Notes

- Once you have confirmed your offer on Summer Programmes 2024*
 - You will NOT be considered for other student exchange programmes in the future (e.g. semester-long student exchange programmes), unless otherwise specified by particular special programmes.
 - Therefore, you are <u>NOT</u> supposed to apply for Student Exchange Programmes 2024-25 (2nd Recruitment) to be launched in February 2024
