The Department of Operations and Risk Management (ORM) offer entrance scholarships aimed at attracting outstanding and high-calibre students. All Year 1 students, including both Local and Non-local applicants, admitted to **BBA (Hons) in Risk and Insurance Management (RIM) [Self-Financed (SF)]** will be eligible for the scholarship awards.

The scholarship scheme is financially supported by the Department of ORM.

Eligibility:

All Year 1 students, including Local and Non-local applicants, admitted to BBA (Hons) in RIM (SF) will be eligible for the scholarship awards.

Quota:

The maximum number of entrance scholarship awards is 6.

Selection Criteria:

The selection will be merit-based and focused on two key areas:

- Academic Performance
- Non-Academic Achievements

The Department will consider the applicants' overall performance in these two areas to decide on the selection and scholarship amount.

Non-Academic:

- Leadership Qualities (e.g., leadership roles or impactful contributions in extracurricular, community, or personal initiatives)
- Performance in art, sports and other activities which can contribute to the University and Department.

Important Notes:

- a. The scholarship decisions will be made based on the information submitted by the applicants for admission.
- b. This is a one-time, non-renewable award.
- c. The scholarship payment will be released to the awardee in two instalments: at the end of first semester of their first and second years, subject to maintaining a **cGPA of 3.0 or above** for the second and subsequent instalments (if any). The Department can adjust the number of instalments after consultation with other units at the University.
- d. Awardee in the following situations will be disqualified from the entrance scholarships and must return the entire scholarship amount to the Department of ORM.
 - Withdrawal from the programme; or
 - Suspension of study; or
 - Change of major/programme; or
 - Submission of false certificates or transcripts.

In case of disputes, the Department reserves the right to make the final decision on the terms and allocation of the scholarships.
