Leadership Scholarships for Global Development and Sustainability Programme

Regulations

Purpose and Background

With the generous donation of HK\$500,000 from Chamber of Young Snow Company Limited (the Donor) to Lingnan University (the University) and HK\$500,000 matching grant from the 8th Matching Grant Scheme, the “Chamber of Young Snow Entrance Scholarships for Global Liberal Arts Programme” (the Scholarships) was established in the academic year 2019/20. The Scholarships has been renamed to the “Chamber of Young Snow Leadership Scholarships for Global Development and Sustainability Programme” since academic year 2022/23. The following regulations shall be effective from the academic year 2025/26 onwards:

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the “Chamber of Young Snow Leadership Scholarships for Global Development and Sustainability Programme” (少雪齋環球可持續發展課程領袖獎學金).
2. The purpose of the Scholarships is to recognise students admitted to the Global Development and Sustainability Programme on the basis of their academic merits and leadership qualities. The Scholarships will be awarded to maximum of three local students and one Myanmar student.
 - a) Local awardee (3 Awardees)
The value of the one-off scholarship shall be HK\$60,000 to cover the followings:
 - i. Full annual tuition fee;
 - ii. Remainder given to student directly for hostel fees, living expenses or experiential learning allowance.
 - b) Myanmar awardee (1 Awardee)
The value of the scholarship will cover the followings:
 - i. Full annual tuition fee;
 - ii. Full annual hostel fee (excluding summer semester);
 - iii. Annual allowance of HK\$10,000 to support study and living expenses;
 - iv. Up to HK\$45,000 allowance to support experiential learning opportunities, including service-learning trips, internships, etc., subject to application and approval.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarships shall be awarded to three local students (Hong Kong permanent resident) and one Myanmar student who are directly admitted to the Global Development and Sustainability Programme via the Joint University Programmes Admission System (JUPAS) or non-JUPAS route on the basis of their academic merits, community service record and/or their leadership vision.

a. Academic merits

(i) JUPAS

The awardee should achieve a total admission score of 23 or above in accordance with the University's "best five subjects approach" admission requirement. The Scholarship will be prioritised for candidate(s), attaining Level 5* or above in either English or Chinese subject in one single sitting in HKDSE.

Or

(ii) Non-JUPAS

The awardee should achieve a total admission score of 30 or above in International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma and pass the panel interview. Other equivalent academic qualifications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

b. Community service record and/or leadership vision

2. The Scholarship of the Myanmar awardee will be awarded on an annual renewal basis subject to the academic performance of the awardees' four-year studies at the University and the availability of funding. Awardees should achieve a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 or above in the previous academic year.

Procedures

1. The School of Interdisciplinary Studies (the "SIS") will administer the Scholarships.
2. The SIS will submit the nominations to the Donor for endorsement via the Office of Institutional Advancement and Public Affairs.
3. The regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donor and the University.
