Brief Course Description:

This course offers an introduction to news writing supported by writing practice. News writings for newspaper, broadcasting, television, and internet will be introduced. This course also trains students the techniques of interviewing and news editing.

**When the course is inclusive of the Service-Learning element, 8-10 students will join the SL.

The scheme enables students to transfer knowledge learnt from the university to the community.

Aims:

This course aims at helping students to grasp the essential elements of news writing. Writing assignments are designed to lay a solid foundation of training for students in terms of the usage of language and styles in handling various formats of news writing.

Learning Outcomes (LOs):

Upon completion of this course, students are expected to:

- 1. understand the nature of journalism;
- 2. grasp the basic techniques of interviewing, news reporting and copy-editing;
- 3. Possess skills of news writing;
- 4. demonstrate the Chinese language proficiency.

Indicative Contents:

1. Introduction to news writing 新聞寫作

- 2. News writing for broadcasting and television 廣播新聞寫作
- 3. News writing for newspapers 報紙新聞寫作
- 4. Feature writing 特寫寫作
- 5. News interviewing 新聞採訪
- 6. News editing 新聞編輯
- 7. News writing for Internet 網絡採編

Teaching Method:

- · Exclusive of Service Learning
- 1.5 hours of lecture and 1.5 hours of tutorial per week. Characteristics and techniques of news reporting and writing are elaborated with examples in lectures. Students are required to discuss samples as well as their own exercises in tutorials. They have to complete three writing assignments in the course.
- · Inclusive of Service Learning

Students are required to attend all lectures and some of the tutorial classes. Besides, students are required to undergo training on conducting interviews and writing techniques. They will conduct face-to-face interviews about a pre-assigned theme with people in the community, and conduct further research and data collection to write an interview article. Therefore, students can act as the bridge between the young generation and the community, facilitating their mutual communication and interaction.

Measurement of Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Grading is by continuous assessment (including written assignments, presentations and attendance)(60%) and examination (40%).
- 2. Course works are weighted up to 60% of the total performance. Students should master the basic techniques of news reporting in the assignment (50%). Tutorials will give training sessions for students to examine news writing samples, discuss, re-write and present their findings. (LO1, LO2, LO3, LO4)
- 3. Students are expected to participate in presentations and discussions to have better learning effect (10%). (LO1, LO2, LO3)
- 4. Examination (40%): Students should show a comprehensive mastering of news writing and general knowledge of public issues. (LO1, LO2, LO3)

Course work: 50%
Presentations: 5%
Discussions: 5%

· Exclusive of Service Learning

Students have to complete a piece of news writing, interview article and feature story about a self-designed theme.

· Inclusive of Service Learning

Students have to complete a piece of interview article and feature story about a preassigned theme that is closely related to the community.
