Course Title : Selected Readings in Classical Chinese Poetry

Brief Course Description:

This course offers a critical study of selected *shi* poets ranging from the Wei-Jin to Song periods. Aspects of traditional Chinese culture explored include Confucian, Daoist and Buddhist world views and ideals of life; the literati's cultural mission and identity; poetry as lyric and social expression; reclusion, utopianism, and the nature-humanity relationship.

Aims:

This course in classical Chinese poetry offers a multiple perspective on recurrent themes, formal attributes, stylistic developments, aesthetic qualities, and cultural-historical contexts. The course also helps students develop independent and analytical thinking.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. demonstrate a sound understanding of basic themes in classical Chinese poetry;
- 2. apply critical concepts and theories learnt in the analysis of classical Chinese poetry;
- 3. demonstrate a basic understanding of traditional Chinese philosophical visions of life:
- 4. demonstrate a basic understanding of Chinese poetic prosody;
- 5. write classical Chinese *shi* poetry.

Indicative Content:

- 1) The lyrical tradition of Chinese poetry 古典詩歌的抒情傳統
- 2) Wei-Jin poetry, e.g. Tao Qian, Xie Lingyun 魏晉詩:如陶潛、謝靈運

- 3) High Tang poetry, e.g. Wang wei, Li Bai, Du Fu 盛唐詩:如王維、李白、杜甫
- 4) Mid-Tang poetry, e.g. Bai Juyi, Liu Yuxi 中唐詩:如白居易、劉禹錫
- 5) Late Tang poetry, e.g. Du Mu, Li Shangyin 晚唐詩:如杜牧、李商隱
- 6) Northern Song poetry, e.g. 北宋詩:如歐陽修、蘇軾
- 7) Southern Song poetry, e.g. 南宋詩:如陸游、范成大
- 8) The aesthetics of classical poetry and its modern vitality 古典詩歌的美學及當 代傳承

Teaching Method:

2 hours of lecture and 1 hour of tutorial per week. Lectures combine macro-analysis of poetic developments, aesthetic principles and cultural-historical contexts with micro-analysis of individual poems, plus poetry chanting to demonstrate sound effects. Tutorials consist of student presentations on specific, assigned topics and class discussion thereon. Students will also submit written reports.

Measurement of Learning Outcomes:

Grading is by continuous assessment (40%, including tutorial performance and written reports) and examination (60%).

- 1. Examination (60%): Students should demonstrate both micro and macro-skills in critical analysis, combined with sound cultural knowledge. They are required to show ability in integration and independent judgment in answering essay-type questions (LO1, LO2, LO3, LO4).
- 2. Tutorial presentation and general class performance (10%): Students are required to show a sound understanding of the assigned topic for reporting, as well as ability in organizing and integrating knowledge. They are required to participate in general class discussions (LO1, LO2, LO3, LO4)...
- 3. Written tutorial report/essay (20%): A revised version of the tutorial report, incorporating comments and feedback of teachers and classmates (LO1, LO2, LO4).
- 4. 2 *shi* poems (10%) covering the 5-character, 7-character, quatrain and regulated forms (LO5).

Assessment:

Examination: 60% (2-hour paper)

Continuous assessment: 40%
