

Course Title	:	Special Topics in Chinese Paleography 古文字學專題

Brief Course Description:

This course introduces students to the study of Chinese paleography and its applications through a range of special topics. The evolution of Chinese characters from oracle bone script to small seal script will be traced. Besides, a selected category of archaic characters, such as the oracle bone script of Shang dynasty, bronze inscriptions of Zhou dynasty and the Spring and Autumn Period, or scripts found on the bamboo slips of the Warring States Period, will be closely examined with emphases on their forms and structural characteristics. Selected ancient texts will be interpreted to demonstrate the applications of Chinese paleography.

Aims:

This course aims at examining a selected topic or a number of closely related topics in Chinese paleography that may not otherwise be properly treated under the regular curriculum. It cultivates in the students an in-depth understanding of Chinese paleography and its applications, so as to breed talents for the study of related disciplines.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to achieve the followings:

1. demonstrate basic concepts of Chinese paleography;
2. demonstrate the principles underlying the structure of archaic characters;
3. demonstrate a thorough and systematic knowledge of the evolution of Chinese characters;
4. apply their knowledge in Chinese paleography to conduct research in ancient texts;
5. demonstrate their analytical skills.

Indicative Content:

- 1) Introduction 導論
- 2) Categories of archaic characters 古文字之類別
- 3) Structural characteristics of archaic characters 古文字之結構
- 4) A Comparison between the *Zhouwen* and *Guwen* as recorded in *Shuowen Jiezi* and archaic characters 《說文解字》所見籀文、古文與古文字之比較
- 5) Evolution of Chinese characters from oracle bone script to small seal script 漢字由甲骨文至小篆之發展及其規律
- 6) The relationship between Chinese paleography and the study of ancient texts 古文字學與古文獻之考釋

Teaching Method:

2 hours of lecture and 1 hour of tutorial per week. Basic concepts and important theories in Chinese paleography will be introduced in lectures. Students are required to study assigned reading materials on specific topics and discuss them in tutorials; the teacher will act as a facilitator of discussion and commentator on students' opinions. Presentations and report-submissions would be incorporated in tutorial teaching.

Measurement of Learning Outcomes:

1. Grading is by continuous assessment (40%, including tutorial performance, oral presentation and written report) and examination (60%).
2. Examination (60%): Students should demonstrate their knowledge of Chinese paleography and its application. In addition, they are required to show their abilities of integration, critical and analytical thinking in answering essay type of questions (LO1, LO2, LO3, LO4, LO5).
3. Tutorial presentation (10%): Students can integrate knowledge and technique of Chinese paleography they have acquired in lectures for the use of their tutorial presentations. They should also facilitate fruitful discussions and debates in the tutorial groups (LO1, LO2, LO4, LO5).
4. Tutorial report (30%): Students are expected to incorporate comments and feedbacks of teachers and group mates for the revision of their written reports. Students need to submit a written report for assessment (LO1, LO2, LO4, LO5).

Assessment:

Examination: 60%

One 2-hour paper

Continuous assessment: 40% (Tutorial presentation 10%, final report 30%)
