

The Best Economics MINOR Students Awards (AY2023-24)

To encourage non-economics major undergraduate students to choose economics as their minor programme, the Department of Economics established “The Best Economics Minor Students Awards”. Lingnan, full-time, non-Economics undergraduate students who, by the end of Term 1 of the 2023-24 AY, have obtained or are expected to obtain an average GPA of 3.33 (B+) or above in at least three economics courses (9 credits) offered by the Department of Economics are eligible to apply. The Department will offer up to 2 awards per year with each award as much as **HK\$3,000**.
