Dr David Wong Yau-kar was born in Hong Kong. He obtained his BA in Economics from the University of Wisconsin, and his MA in Economics and his PhD in Economics from the University of Chicago. Dr Wong is currently Managing Director of United Overseas Investments Ltd.

Dr Wong has extensive experience in manufacturing, international trade, corporate finance and policy research. He served as an economist at the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia, USA from 1987 to 1991. He currently serves on the boards of a number of listed and non-listed companies.

Dr Wong has an extensive record in public service. He holds significant positions in various business and professional organisations. He is a past President of the Chinese Manufacturers' Association of Hong Kong, and he currently serves as Chairman of the Business & Professionals Federation of Hong Kong, Deputy Chairman of the Hong Kong Institute of Directors, and Vice President of the Hong Kong Professionals & Senior Executives Association. Dr Wong also serves on many government and non-governmental consultative and advisory bodies. He is currently Chairman of the Land & Development Advisory Committee, Chairman of the Protection of Wages on Insolvency Fund Board as well as a member of the Preparatory Task Force for Economic Development Commission, the Exchange Fund Advisory Committee, and the Hong Kong Trade Development Council, among others.
