Address by President

In 1967, Lingnan was re-established in Hong Kong as Lingnan College and in 1999 it's renamed Lingnan University. It has been a pioneer in liberal arts education in Asia, addressing diverse challenges of our time with cutting-edge solutions. And it has been a partner in community development, contributing to the well-being and prosperity of Hong Kong and beyond.

Lingnan is now an internationally recognised global leader in providing quality education and conducting high-impact research. Lingnan is currently ranked second in the world for "Quality Education" in the Times Higher Education Impact Rankings. Additionally, Lingnan has achieved the highest rating of 5+ Stars in the recent QS 5-Stars Assessment.

As we embark on a new chapter of our journey, we face unprecedented opportunities and challenges. The world is changing rapidly, and so are the needs and expectations of our society. We must adapt and evolve, while staying true to our core values and mission. We must embrace diversity and inclusion, while fostering a sense of belonging and identity. We must pursue excellence and innovation, while maintaining academic integrity and quality. And we must balance local relevance and global impact, while enhancing our reputation and influence.

We are determined to make the following four connections.

First, we must build connections between traditional programmes and the digital revolution. We are providing Lingnan staff and students with free access to ChatGPT and GPT 4.0, enabling us to remain at the forefront of digital breakthroughs. Technologies like artificial intelligence are empowering every part of our life and work. We are set to become a leading liberal arts university of the digital age. Fourth, we need to connect well to Lingnan's past, drawing inspiration and confidence from Lingnan's rich history and heritage of 135 years. We hold our motto, "作育英才,服務社會", or "Education for Service", close to our hearts. Our Lingnan spirit is characterised by passion, loyalty, perseverance, openness, and a commitment to service. With this spirit, and a shared goal to excel in the digital era, we will make a significant difference and propel Lingnan to new heights.

Last but foremost, student education is at the very core of our mission. We will expand initiatives and activities to enrich our student experience and foster our community engagement. We will instill the spirit of innovation in everything we do as a way of life. We have established the Lingnan Entrepreneurship Initiative (LEI) to provide training, mentorship, funding, and networking opportunities for our students. We have also launched the Lingnan Arts Festival (LAF) annual gala to showcase our cultural diversity and creativity. Moreover, we will continue to support our students in participating in various local and international competitions, internships, exchange programmes, service-learning projects, and other co-curricular activities that enhance their experiential learning and personal growth.

To achieve these goals, we need the collective wisdom, passion and commitment of our entire Lingnan community. We need to work together as one team, with a shared vision and a common purpose. We need to listen to each other, respect each other and support each other. And we need to celebrate our achievements, learn from our past and grow from our experiences.
