LINGNAN UNIVERSITY

A Summary of Discussions and the Decisions of the Council Meeting Held on 25 April 2016

- 1. The Council WELCOMED the Student Member, Mr CHENG Pui-lun, the new President of the Students' Union, who attended the Council meeting for the first time.
- 2. The Council RECEIVED a report from the President on the activities of the University, including
 - (a) The University has signed inter-institutional agreements of cooperation with the following institutions, viz. National Taiwan University (Taiwan), Seoul National University (Korea), the University of Hradec Králové (Czech Republic) and Vytautas Magnus University (Lithuania).
 - (b) The University has renewed inter-institutional agreements of cooperation with Alverno College (USA), Donghua University (China), and Pusan National University (Korea).
 - (c) The University has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Emerson College (USA) to promote international cooperation in education and research.
 - (d) The University has signed agreements for student exchange with Manchester Metropolitan University (United Kingdom), the University of Strathclyde (United Kingdom) and Yuanpei College of Peking University (China).
 - (e) Starting from 2016-17, the University and Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) will jointly offer a Double-Master Degree Programme in Research in Economic Analysis and International Banking and Finance.
 - (f) The Centre for Public Policy Studies (CPPS) of Lingnan University and China Institute of Regulation Research (CIRR) of Zhejiang University of Finance and Economics signed a strategic collaboration agreement. The collaboration agreement aims to promote close cooperation between the two parties in research on competition policy and government regulations.
 - (g) The University has become a partner of the Centre for Global Higher Education (CGHE), the largest research centre in the world specifically focused on higher education and its future development.
 - (h) The University received a generous donation from The Ho Iu Kwong Charity Foundation to support a new China Economic Research Programme which aims to foster the research in the areas of economic and financial development and entrepreneurship of Mainland China and Hong Kong.
 - (i) Prof. Cai Zongqi, Lee Wing Tat Chair Professor of Chinese Literature, has been awarded the Humanities and Social Sciences Prestigious Fellowship by the Research Grants Council (RGC) for the 2015-16 funding exercise.
 - (j) Ms Jenny Lam Wing-yee, a final year student of Social and Public Policy Study, has been awarded the prestigious Sir Edward Youde Memorial Scholarship.
 - (k) Lingnan students won numerous awards in the 10th Hong Kong Inter-tertiary Institution Putonghua Recitation Contest, including the Championships in Poetry Group Recitation and Solo Recitation (Section of International Students), held on 19 March 2016.
 - (l) The Lingnan University Chinese Debate Team was crowned the champion in the Joint-Universities Debate Competition 2016 co-organised by the Radio &

- Television Hong Kong and The Hong Kong Federation of Students on 18 April 2016. Year 4 student Ms Wong Shu-man awarded the Best Debater of the match.
- (m) Lingnan University Fundraising Dinner 2016 was held on 21 April 2016 at Sheraton Hong Kong Hotel & Towers. The Dinner aimed to raise funds for the "First Generation University Education Fund" which supports students who are the first generation in their families receiving university education in joining whole-person development programmes provided by the University. Professor Frederick Ma Si-hang, former Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development of the HKSAR Government and currently the Chairman of MTR Corporation Limited, was the Guest Speaker to give a talk on "Opportunities and Challenges for MTR in Years Ahead".

 - (a) 3+3+4 Academic System (the Simon and Eleanor Kwok Building, Wong Hoo Chuen Hall & Wu Jieh Yee Hall);
 - (b) the Jockey Club New Hall;
 - (c) improvement works to Mr and Mrs Lam Kau Yui Fitness Centre and changing rooms at indoor sports complex and extension of spectator stand at outdoor sports ground;
 - (d) improvement works to the existing disabled lift at the Chan Tak Tai Auditorium;
 - (e) re-arrangement of the Fong Sum Wood Library's study area at 2/F and 3/F of Patrick Lee Wan Keung Academic Building and Wong Administration Building;
 - (f) new covered walkway connecting the existing Jockey Club Hall to the entrance of Student Function Hall:
 - (g) improvement works to the student bedrooms, common corridors, bathroom and lavatory facilities of the student hostels; and
 - (h) UGC's approved AA&I projects for 2016-17.
- 5. The Council CONFIRMED the appointments of Dr HO Wing, Rosiah and Dr YEUNG Kai Yin, Tommy as members to the Court with effect from 29 April 2016 for a term of three years.
- 6. The Council APPOINTED Mr CHENG Pui-lun as Student Member of the Review Panel of the Lingnan University Ordinance as nominated by the Lingnan University Students' Union with immediate effect.

- 7. The Council APPOINTED Mr CHENG Pui-lun and Mr TSE Kwan-ho as members of the Board of Governors of the Community College at Lingnan University and Lingnan Institute of Further Education with effect from 29 April 2016 for a term of one year.
- 8. The Council APPROVED the revisions to the terms of reference of the Audit Committee.
- 9. The Council RECEIVED the Report from the Staffing Committee and APPROVED its recommendation on the following for implementation:
 - (a) proposal for Research-Track appointments and Teaching-Track appointments with the implementation details of these appointments to be worked out for deliberation and approval by the Senate and then for reporting to the Council;
 - (b) "Guidelines for Performance Review and Personnel Actions of Academic Staff Members at the ranks of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor";
 - (c) "Guidelines for Performance Review and Personnel Actions of Academic Staff Members at the ranks of Teaching Fellow and Language Instructor";
 - (d) proposed Sabbatical Leave scheme for academic staff;
 - (e) proposal for revising the current leave arrangement for academic staff at the rank of Assistant Professor or above; and
 - (f) proposal for paternity leave.

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
