

Lam Yuen Man Memorial Scholarships

Regulations

Purpose and Background

With the generous donation from the late Ms Chung Yu Juen Betty Jamie (the Donor) to Lingnan University (the University), the “Lam Yuen Man Memorial Scholarships” (the Scholarships) are established. The Scholarships will be effective from the academic year 2016/17 to 2020/21 with the following regulations.

1. The Scholarships shall be known as “Lam Yuen Man Memorial Scholarships” (林苑文紀念獎學金).
2. The Scholarships will be awarded to three students in each academic year. The value of each scholarship will be HK\$18,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarships shall be awarded to three local undergraduate students with financial needs from Department of Sociology and Social Policy, Department of History and Department of Translation of the University.
2. Awardees should obtain outstanding academic achievements at entrance for Year 1 students; or achieve a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.00 or above for Year 2 to Year 4 students.

Procedures

1. Nomination from the Departments shall reach the Student Services Centre. Student Services Centre will forward it to the Donor for endorsement and copy to the Office of Institutional Advancement and Alumni Affairs.
2. The above regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Executor Office of the Estate of the Donor and the University.
