

Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund Exchange and Hostel Scholarships

Regulations

Purpose and Background

With the generous donation from Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund (the Donor) to Lingnan University (the University), “Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund Exchange and Hostel Scholarships” (the Scholarships) were established since 2013/14. The Scholarships have been extended for another five years with effect from the academic year 2017/18 and the updated regulations are as follows:

Part A - Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund Exchange Scholarships

1. The Scholarships will be known as the “Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund Exchange Scholarships” (信興教育及慈善基金學生交流獎學金).
2. The Scholarships will be effective for five years from the academic year 2018/19 to 2022/23.
3. The Scholarships will be awarded to ten students in each academic year.
4. The value of each scholarship shall be HK\$5,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarships will be awarded to full-time undergraduate students who will go on exchange for at least one semester.
2. Students should achieve a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.00 or above.
3. Students must be permanent residents in Hong Kong.

Procedures

1. The Office of Global Education will administer the Scholarships and nominate eligible students.
2. The Office of Institutional Advancement and Alumni Affairs will submit the nominations to the Donor for endorsement.
3. The above regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donor and the University.

Part B - Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund Hostel Scholarships

1. The Scholarships will be known as the “Shun Hing Education and Charity Fund Hostel Scholarships”. (信興教育及慈善基金住宿獎學金)
2. The Scholarships will be effective for five years from the academic year 2017/18 to 2021/22.
3. The Scholarships will be awarded to ten students in each academic year.
4. The value of each scholarship shall be HK\$5,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarships will be awarded to full-time undergraduate students who are living at the hostels with financial needs.
2. Each awardee should achieve good academic results.

Procedures

1. The Student Services Centre will administer the Scholarships.
2. The Student Services Centre will submit the nominations of the Scholarships to the Donor for endorsement.
3. The regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donor and the University.
