

Mr Wong Sai Ping Memorial Scholarships Regulations

Purpose and Background

In recognition of academic achievements of students, the Lingnan Alumni Association Foundation, San Francisco (the Donor) has agreed to donate US\$10,000 to establish three (3) annual scholarships (the Scholarships) in Lingnan University (the University) for nine consecutive years from 2010/11 to 2018/2019 with the following regulations:

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the “Mr Wong Sai Ping Memorial Scholarships” (黃西平學長紀念獎學金).
2. The value of each Scholarship shall be HK\$3,000 per annum. The Scholarship will be awarded to (3) students annually. In the event that donation in the final year is not enough for 3 students, it will be awarded to two students evenly.

Eligibility

The Scholarships shall be awarded to three (3) full-time Year 2 or above undergraduate students from three (3) different study programmes of the University each year. The Scholarships will be awarded according to the following order of the study programmes:

- i) Business Administration
- ii) Chinese
- iii) Contemporary English Studies
- iv) Cultural Studies
- v) History
- vi) Philosophy
- vii) Social Sciences
- viii) Translation
- ix) Visual Studies

Criteria

The selection criterion for the Scholarships shall be on academic achievements. If there are candidates of comparable academic merit, their involvements in extra-curricular activities shall also be taken into consideration.

Procedures

1. The nominations from respective Departments/Programmes should be sent to the Student Services Centre who will forward the result to the Donor for approval.
2. The above regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donor and the University.
