

CIMA Prizes

Regulations

Purpose and Background

In recognition of academic achievements of students, the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants has established annual prizes in the University with effect from the academic year 2001/02. The following regulations shall apply as of 2018/19.

1. The Prizes shall be known as the “CIMA Prizes” (特許管理會計師公會獎).
2. There shall be three awards in kind (value at £187 each) to cover annual subscription and registration fees.

Eligibility

The Prizes shall be awarded to three full-time undergraduate students in Business Administration.

Criteria

The students should have achieved outstanding academic performance in “ACT202 Cost Accounting”. But if there are candidates of comparable academic merits, their involvement in extra-curricular activities should also be taken into consideration.

Procedure

1. Nominations from the Director of Business Programmes shall reach the Student Services Centre which will forward the list to the donor for approval.
2. These regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the donor and the University.
