

HKICS Foundation Subject Prizes

Purpose and Background

In recognition of academic achievements of students, The Hong Kong Institute of Chartered Secretaries Foundation Limited has established an annual prize scheme in the University with effect from the academic year 1995/96. The following regulations shall apply as of 2018/19.

- 1. The Awards shall be known as the "HKICS Foundation Subject Prizes" (香港特許秘書基 金科目獎).
- 2. The Prizes will be awarded to two students. The value of each Prize shall be HK\$3,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

- 1. The Subject Prizes shall be awarded to one full-time undergraduate student who has achieved the best result in the subject of Company Law and one full-time undergraduate student who has achieved the best result in the subject of Corporate Social Responsibility under BBA programme respectively.
- 2. The nominees must have achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3 in the previous academic year.
- 3. If there are candidates of comparable academic merit, their involvement in extra-curricular activities should also be taken into consideration.

Procedure

- 1. Nominations from Faculty of Business shall reach the Student Services Centre which will forward the list to the donor for endorsement.
- 2. The Student Services Centre will administer the Prizes.
- 3. These regulations may be revised and subject to mutual agreement between the donor and the University.
