

The Hong Kong Federation of Insurers Scholarships

Purpose and Background

To encourage tertiary education on insurance, The Hong Kong Federation of Insurers Educational Trust has established annual scholarships in the University with effect from the academic year 2004/05. The following regulations shall apply as of 2018/19.

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the ‘The Hong Kong Federation of Insurers Scholarships (香港保險業聯會獎學金)’.
2. The value of each award shall be HK\$20,000 per annum.

Eligibility

3. The Scholarships shall be awarded to four full-time local Year 3 or above undergraduate students majoring in Risk and Insurance Management.

Criteria

4. The scholarships shall be awarded on the basis of academic merit. The Board of Trustees of the Federation has the discretionary power to decide the total number of scholarships to be awarded.

Procedure

5. As stipulated by the Donor, the candidates nominated by the University must be among the top six students in their class and have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above. A Trustee of the Federation will participate in the selection process by joining a panel of judges including the officials from the University.
