The Best Economics Minor Students Awards

Purpose and Background

To encourage non-economics major undergraduate students to choose economics as their minor programme, the Department of Economics of the University decided to establish an annual scheme of awards/scholarship in the University with effect from the academic year 2017-18. The following criteria will apply as of 2018/19:

1. The Awards shall be known as the “The Best Economics Minor Students Awards” (副修經濟學優秀學生獎學金).
2. There shall be up to two awards per year. The value of each award shall be up to HK\$3,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarships shall be open to final year full-time non-Economics undergraduate students* who have obtained average GPA3.0 or above in all economics courses after successful completion of 15 credits in economics (five courses) as required.
2. The awardees should obtain confirmation of the Minor Programme in Economics and be expected to graduate in the end 2018-19.
3. Selection of the awards shall be based on excellent academic performance.

Procedure

1. Nominations from the Department of Economics shall reach the Student Services Centre.
2. These regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the donor and the University.

* A full time undergraduate student is required to take at least 12 credits with undergraduate courses per term, i.e. 4 with undergraduate courses with 3 credits each.
