

Cultural Studies Alumni Scholarship

Regulations

Purpose and Background

With the generous donation of HK\$10,000 from the graduates of Cultural Studies (the Donor) to Lingnan University (the University), the “Cultural Studies Alumni Scholarship” (the Scholarship) was established in 2015. The Scholarship seeks to promote students' critical social engagement. The Scholarship will be awarded to students of Lingnan University from the academic year 2018/19 with the following regulations.

1. The Scholarship shall be known as the “Cultural Studies Alumni Scholarship” (文化研究舊生獎學金).
2. The Scholarship will be awarded to one student in 2018/19 academic year. The value of the Scholarship is HK\$10,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarship shall be awarded to Year 2 or above, full-time undergraduate student majoring in Cultural Studies.
2. Awardee should have achieved a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 or above, together with an outstanding performance in a written assignment of Cultural Studies related to “liberty”, “democracy”, “justice” or “fairness” during the year.
3. If there is candidate of comparable academic merit, his/her involvement in extra-curricular activities shall also be taken into consideration.

Procedures

1. The Student Services Centre will administer the Scholarship.
2. Nomination from the Department of Cultural Studies shall reach the Student Services Centre. The Student Services Centre will submit the nomination to the Donor for endorsement and copy to the Office of Institutional Advancement and Alumni Affairs.
3. The regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donor and the University.
