

# Career DC Internships in Australia & New Zealand

*This is a programme coordinated by SSC-Career Advising Services with our working partner CareerDC of Australia.*

## Internship cities:

1. Australia: Sydney, Melbourne, Perth, Brisbane & Adelaide....
2. New Zealand: Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch....

**Programme Duration:** 6 -24 weeks

**Programme date: Flexible** – plan according to your schedule. However, non-final year students under SSC subsidy MUST return to Hong Kong no later than 31 August 2019.

**Internship type:** Unpaid internship (mostly)

**Target students:** Open to all full-time undergraduate students from all study programmes with valid HKSAR passport, or students who came from countries with work holiday agreement with Australia / New Zealand.

**Programme Fee:**

**(1) Placement service only: A\$1,600\* per student (airfare, visa fees, and accommodation not included)**

**(2) Placement service + homestay accommodation for 10 weeks: A\$6,000 for 10 weeks (airfare, visa fees not included)**

**Travel Insurance:** If you are eligible to receive subsidy of HK\$16,000 from the Student Services Centre, you will be covered by Lingnan’s Group Travel Insurance during your internship period (conditions apply).

**Accommodation:** for shared room / apartment (for reference only) ranging from A\$160 - 350 per week in Sydney / Melbourne  
 \*\* Homestay: A\$110 - 270 per week / NZ\$150 - 350 per week

**Living Expenses: (for reference only)**  
 approx. A\$250 per week  
 approx. NZ\$250 per week

**Application Method:**

1. Submit your application directly to CareerDC online:

2. Once CareerDC accepted you and you also receive internship placement, submit our Global Internship Subsidy Form to SSC for processing of your subsidy:

## Subsidy to Students:

Subsidy will be provided to eligible full-time undergraduate students only with satisfactory cGPA – meaning 2.0 and above.

For no-pay internships, subsidy is capped at HK\$16,000 per student for an 8-week+ internship. For paid internships, subsidy is capped at HK\$8,000 per student for an 8-week+ internship.
