

Szto Wai Art Scholarship

Regulations

Purpose and Background

Mr Szto Wai was a dedicated educator and an artist who contributed his life in education to cultivate young talents, won the respect from all Lingnians. He drew and designed the Lingnan logo which was officially adopted in 1911. The red and grey colours of the logo symbolize loyalty and integrity, strength and perseverance, the qualities of the Lingnan spirit, which inspires Lingnians everywhere as they march their way to the future. Lingnan University (the University) had received donations from Lingnians to establish a scholarship scheme in honour and memory of Mr Szto Wai for his remarkable contributions to Lingnan. The “Szto Wai Art Scholarship” (the Scholarship) is established in January 2019. The following regulations shall be effective from academic year 2018/19 onward.

1. The Scholarship shall be known as the “Szto Wai Art Scholarship” (司徒衛藝術獎學金).
2. The Scholarship will be awarded to one student in each academic year. The value of the scholarship will be HK\$10,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarship shall be awarded to one full-time undergraduate student majoring in Visual Studies.
2. Awardee should have achieved a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.00 or above and be recommended by the Head of the Department of Visual Studies.

Procedures

1. The Student Services Centre will administer the Scholarship.
2. Nomination from Department of Visual Studies shall reach the Student Services Centre. The Student Services Centre will forward a copy to the Office of Institutional Advancement and Alumni Affairs.
3. The regulations may be revised by the University if necessary.
