

CPA Australia Excellence Awards

Regulations

Purpose and Background

In recognition of academic achievements of students, CPA Australia (the donor) has established annual awards at Lingnan University (the University) with effect from the academic year 1999/2000. The following regulations shall apply in 2019/20:

1. The Awards shall be known as “CPA Australia Excellence Awards” (澳洲會計師公會卓越表現獎).
2. There shall be **two awards** of approximately **HK\$9,300 each** in the form of Assessment fee waiver, one year membership subscription fee waiver and exam fee waiver for one professional segment.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Awards shall be awarded to **two** students regardless of their residency status.
2. The awardees should be full-time final-year students in BBA – Accountancy Stream or students in Master of Accountancy Programme.
3. The selection criteria for the Awards shall be on academic achievements and willingness to take CPA Australia exam upon graduation.
4. The selected candidates should meet the admission requirements for Associate membership of CPA Australia Ltd.

Procedures

1. The Student Services Centre will administer the Awards.
2. Maximum four nominations, two from Hong Kong residents and two from the People’s Republic of China from Department of Accountancy, shall reach the Student Services Centre, which will forward the list to the donor for conducting phone interviews and copy to the Office of Institutional Advancement and Alumni Affairs.
3. The final award recipients will be advised by CPA Australia Ltd to the Student Services Centre.
4. These regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the donor and the University.
