

The Bank of East Asia Scholarships

Regulations

Purpose and Background

With the generous donation of HK\$60,000 from The Bank of East Asia Charitable Foundation (the Donor) to Lingnan University (the University), “The Bank of East Asia Scholarships” (the Scholarships) were established since 2014/15. The following regulations shall apply in 2019/20:

1. The Scholarships shall be known as “The Bank of East Asia Scholarships” (東亞銀行獎學金).
2. The Scholarships will be awarded to six students in 2019/20 academic year. The value of each scholarship will be HK\$10,000 per annum.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Scholarships shall be awarded to six year 3 or above full-time undergraduate students from the Accounting, Finance and General Business Management programmes.
2. Awardees should achieve a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.4 or above and preferably have not won other scholarships during the year.
3. If there are candidates of comparable academic merits, preference should be given to Hong Kong permanent residents and/or with financial needs.

Procedures

1. The Student Services Centre will administer the Scholarships.
2. The Student Services Centre will submit the nominations to the Donor for endorsement and copy to the Office of Institutional Advancement and Alumni Affairs.
3. The regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donor and the University.
