

Hong Kong Wong Clan Association Scholarships

Regulations

Purpose and Background

In recognition of academic achievements of students, Hong Kong Wong Clan Association (the Donor) donated HK\$100,000 to Lingnan University (the University) for the establishment of an endowment fund to provide annual scholarships with effect from the academic year 1995/96.

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the “Hong Kong Wong Clan Association Scholarships” (香港黃族宗親會獎學金).
2. The endowment fund shall be invested at the discretion of the Comptroller of the University unless otherwise specified by the Donor. Annual interest generated from the fund will be used for awarding prizes.
3. The minimum value of each award shall be HK\$1,000 per annum covered by the interest generated.

Eligibility

The Scholarships shall be awarded to three full-time students, one from each of the Faculties - Arts, Business and Social Sciences respectively who have achieved outstanding academic results in Practical Chinese I in the previous year.

Criteria

The selection criterion for the awards shall be on academic achievements. But if there are candidates of comparable academic merit, their involvement in extra-curricular activities should also be taken into consideration.

Procedure

1. The Student Services Centre will administer the Scholarships.
2. The Student Services Centre will submit the recommendations of the Scholarships to the Donors for approval.
3. The regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the Donors and the University.
