

Hong Kong Association of University Women Annual Scholarships

Purpose and Background

In recognition of academic achievements of female students, Hong Kong Association of University Women administers a scholarship scheme offering annual scholarships for full-time female students studying in local universities. The following regulations shall apply as of 2019/20.

1. The Scholarships shall be known as the “Hong Kong Association of University Annual Scholarships” (大學婦女香港協會獎學金).
2. The value of each award for undergraduates shall be HK\$5,000. The value of each award for postgraduates shall be HK\$20,000.
3. Candidates from the University have to compete with those from other universities for the scholarships.

Eligibility

a. Undergraduate Scholarships

Candidates should be full-time Year 2 or Year 3 female undergraduates of the University and member of the Hong Kong Association of University Women.

b. Postgraduate Scholarships

Candidates should be members of the Hong Kong Association of University Women.

Criteria

a. Undergraduate Scholarships

The candidates should have outstanding academic achievements.

b. Postgraduate Scholarships

The candidates should have outstanding achievement while undertaking a postgraduate course in the University. Particular quality in leadership and community contribution will also be taken into consideration.

Procedure

1. As for undergraduate scholarships, Student Services Centre will ask the Registry to give the names of female Year 2 and Year 3 students who have obtained the highest cumulative GPA respectively in each of the Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Business and Faculty of Social Sciences in the last academic year. The names of the candidates will be sent to the donor for their consideration.
2. As for postgraduate scholarships, Student Services Centre will invite female postgraduate students to apply. Their applications will be sent to the Donor for their consideration. The shortlisted candidate will be invited to attend an interview conducted by the Association.
