Programme Structure for 2018-19 Intake (4-year curriculum)

The student-designed major is open to outstanding students admitted to the Faculty of Arts. The 48 credits for the student-designed major will normally comprise courses offered by departments in the Faculty of Arts and a minimum of 24 credits should comprise courses at the 3000 or 4000 level. @ A student should include the selected 14 courses offered by Departments/ Wong Bing Lai Music and Performing Arts Unit in the Faculty of Arts, i.e. courses with letter code of "CHI/ENG/CUS/HST/MPA/PHI/TRA/VIS", in the application. The application will be considered by the Associate Dean (Undergraduate Studies), the Arts Faculty Management Board (AFMB) and Academic Quality Assurance Committee (AQAC) for approval. With approval of the Dean, up to 12 credits of the major may be taken outside the Arts Faculty.

Free Electives

Students may select courses in any disciplines to obtain the total number of credits required for graduation, subject to timetable, course load and study scheme constraints.
