## REQUIREMENTS IN CHINESE LITERATURE, HISTORY AND PHILOSOPHY

Students are required to complete 15 credits from two of the disciplines and 12 credits from the third discipline, according to the lists below. In addition, students are required to complete a year-long Directed Research (DR) Project (6 credits). For the DR Project, each student will have one chief supervisor plus a second reader from a different discipline than the chief supervisor. Students can choose to complete their DR projects in either Chinese or English.
