RUS1101 Russian (Beginner Level) (non credit-bearing)

(Recommended: Cumulative GPA of 2.2)

The course focuses on introducing students to an additional language and culture with a view to developing their awareness of the global workplace. The emphasis is on providing students with an enjoyable, stimulating and interactive learning experience by creating opportunities for them to discover the new culture and practice using the language.

RUS1201 Russian (Post-Beginner Level) (non credit-bearing)

(Recommended: Cumulative GPA of 2.2)

(Prerequisite for 2013-14 or before: Successful completion of RUS1101 or successful completion of an equivalent course)

The course is the continuation of the RUS1101 and continues to develop students' ability to use Russian for communicative purpose and their awareness of Russian culture with a view to preparing them to enter the global workplace. The emphasis is again on providing students with an enjoyable and interactive learning experience by creating opportunities for them to discover the new culture and practice using the language.
