

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS 科目簡介

COURSES FOR 4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

CRE1101 Media - Culture - Creativity 傳媒、文化與創意 (3 credits)

The course will acquaint students with creative approaches in a wide field of cultural and media products. Students will study existing examples of creative output both in high and low culture, and will be encouraged to develop their own projects on the basis of these examples. They will be encouraged to “think outside the box” both in regard to their respective disciplines and their methods. Emphasis will be placed not only on individual creativity, but also on developing new ideas and approaches in a group. Project work will guide students along the difficult and labour-intensive process of translating creative inspiration into a final product.

CRE1161 Creativity Workshop 創意工作坊 (3 credits)

This course would be predicated upon practical creativity linked to the more theoretical input provided by other courses constituting the Minor in Creativity. Students can opt for 2 workshops from a menu of 5. The orientation of the workshops can change according to the desired emphasis of the course designers, needs and interests of students, visiting staff expertise and other variables. However, a typical menu would offer practical sessions of the following types/genres:

- * Film and Visual Culture workshop
- * Drama workshop - live and audio-recorded drama
- * Painting/ Calligraphy/ Pottery workshop
- * Dance and Movement workshop
- * Music and Recitation workshop
