## **Minor in Visual Studies**

The Department of Digital Arts and Creative Industries offers the Minor in Visual Studies.

## For students from the 2020-21 intake and onwards

Students whose Major is in any programmes\* other than BA (Hons) Visual Studies wishing to take a Minor in Visual Studies will be required to earn 15 Visual Studies credits from courses under the BA Visual Studies Programme. At least 3 of these credits must come from VIS2101 Histories of Chinese Art (titled as Introduction to Chinese Art in 2021-22 or before) or VIS2105 Film Art and Storytelling or VIS2107 Arts of Europe (titled as Appreciation of Western Art in 2021-22 or before). At least 9 credits must come from the courses mentioned above and/or programme elective courses from Category I: History and Theory of Visual Arts and Category II: Interdisciplinary Subjects of the BA Visual Studies Programme of the 2020-21 intake and after.

## For students in the 2019-20 intake and before

Students whose Major is in any programmes\* other than BA (Hons) Visual Studies wishing to take a Minor in Visual Studies will be required to earn 15 Visual Studies credits from courses under the BA Visual Studies Programme. At least 3 of these credits must come from the required courses of the BA Visual Studies Programme, viz. VIS2101 Histories of Chinese Art (titled as Introduction to Chinese Art in 2021-22 or before) or VIS2104 Art from Romanticism to Modernism (titled as Western Art from Romanticism to Modernism in 2021-22 or before) or VIS2105 Film Art and Storytelling or VIS2107 Arts of Europe (titled as Appreciation of Western Art in 2021-22 or before) or VIS2202 Philosophy of Visual Arts (not offered from 2022-23). At least 9 credits must come from the required courses mentioned above and/or programme elective courses from categories 1 and 2 of the BA Visual Studies Programme (Category I: History and Theory of Visual Arts; Category II: Interdisciplinary Subjects in the programme structure of the 2020-21 intake and after) (titled as History of the Visual Arts and Aesthetics; Visual Studies Service-Learning in the programme structure of the 2019-20 intake or before).

\* A course in the 48-credit major disciplines of the BA (Hons) Film and Media Studies that is used for fulfillment of the programme requirements cannot be double counted for fulfillment of the requirements of this Minor.
