Minor in International Studies (for those registered for this Minor programme up to the 2022-23 academic year)

In the present context of accelerating global interdependence, an understanding of important international political and economic issues is highly relevant for Lingnan students. Indeed, becoming a global citizen is part of Lingnan's whole-person education philosophy. This Minor will allow non-government and international affairs/ political science students to enhance their international awareness so as to compete effectively in the global market place.

The Office of the Faculty of Social Sciences coordinates the offering of the Minor in International Studies.

Students whose Major is in any programmes other than BSocSc in Government and International Affairs/ Political Science may qualify for a Minor in International Studies after successful completion of five courses (15 credits). They consist of one required course and four elective courses as detailed below:
