The Best Economics Minor Students Awards

Purpose and Background

To encourage non-economics major undergraduate students to choose economics as their minor programme, the Department of Economics of the University decided to establish an annual scheme of awards/scholarship in the University with effect from the academic year 2017-18. The following criteria will apply as of 2019/20:

1. The Awards shall be known as the “The Best Economics Minor Students Awards” (副修經濟學優秀學生獎學金).
2. There shall be up to two awards per year. The value of each award shall be up to HK\$3,000 per annum.
3. The students shall submit applications or nominations by subject teachers to Economics General Office on or before 31 January 2020.

Eligibility and Criteria

1. The Awards shall be open to Lingnan full-time non-Economics undergraduate students*, who have obtained/expected to obtain average GPA3.33 (B+) or above in at least three economics courses (9 credits) offered by Department of Economics in Term 1 AY2019-20.
2. The awardees should obtain confirmation of the Minor Programme in Economics from the Registry in Term 1 AY2019-20.
3. Selection of the awards shall be based on excellent academic performance and students may invite to attend interviews

Procedure

1. Nominations from the Department of Economics shall reach the Student Services Centre.
2. These regulations may be revised subject to mutual agreement between the donor and the University.

* A full time undergraduate student is required to take at least 12 credits with undergraduate courses per term, i.e. 4 with undergraduate courses with 3 credits each.

The Department of Economics reserves the rights to withdraw the awards if the awardee failed to complete the minor programme.
