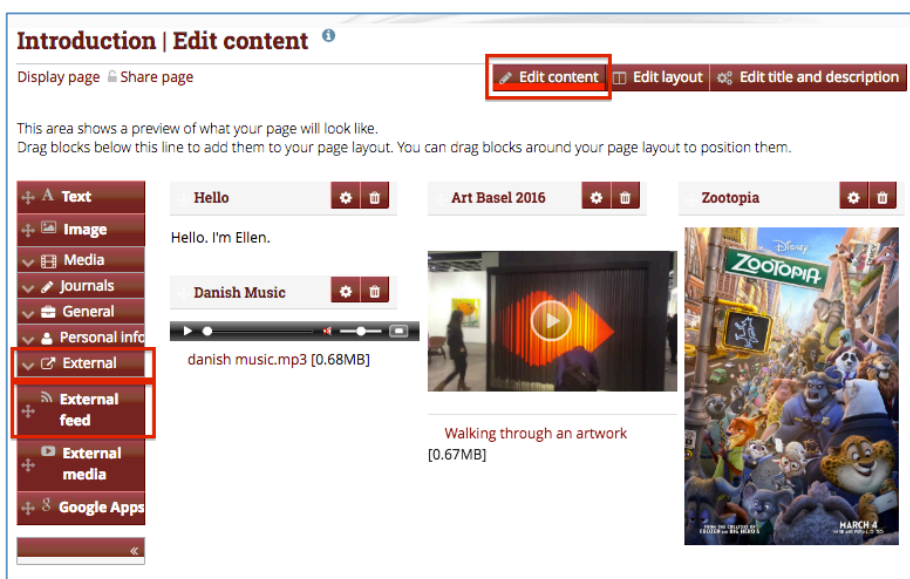
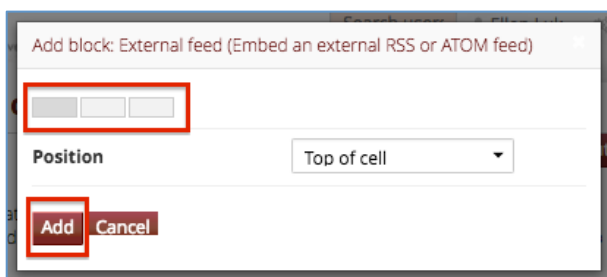


How to insert a RSS feed into a page

1. Login to Mahara and click the '**Portfolio**' tab.
2. Select a page for editing by clicking its edit button (✎).
3. From the '**External content**' tab, select the '**External Feed**' sub-tab.



4. Choose the position of the block.



5. In the Configuration screen, input the name of your feed in the '**Block Title**'.
6. Input the URL of the RSS feed in the '**Feed location**'
(e.g. Local Weather Forecast: <http://rss.weather.gov.hk/rss/LocalWeatherForecast.xml>)
7. Select the number of feed items to show and check whether to show feed items in full.
8. Click '**Save**' to finish.

External feed: Configure

Block title
If you leave this blank, the title of the feed will be used.

Feed location *
URL of a valid RSS or ATOM feed

Insecure SSL mode No
Disable SSL certificate verification. This is not recommended but might be necessary if the feed is served using an invalid or untrusted certificate.

HTTP username
Username (HTTP basic authentication) needed to access this feed (if required)

HTTP password
Password (HTTP basic authentication) needed to access this feed (if required)

Items to show
Between 1 and 20

Show feed items in full No
Whether to show a summary of the feed items or show the full text for each one.

Retractable
Select to allow this block to be retracted when the header is clicked.

Showers are affecting the coast of Guangdong and the northern part of the South China Sea.

Typhoon Nepartak has intensified into a severe typhoon. At 10 p.m., Nepartak was centred about 1460 kilometres east-southeast of Gaoxiong. It is forecast to move northwest at about 30 kilometres per hour in the general direction of east of Luzon to Taiwan.

Weather forecast for tonight and tomorrow:
 Mainly cloudy with occasional showers and isolated squally thunderstorms. Temperatures will range between 26 and 32 degrees. Moderate east to southeasterly winds, occasionally fresh offshore at first.

Outlook: Very hot apart from isolated showers in the following couple of days.
