Job description

- Plan and execute project activities;
- Assist in daily centre/project operation;
- The total workload of a student will be 1 initiated activities, 1 assigned mini project and routine operation work;
- Student is required to report to our staff weekly;
- Student with good performance may be recruited as part-time staff after the internship to sustain their project.

Key Responsibilities & Assigned Mini Mission

Student A (Children and Family Service) (Shum Shui Po)

「快樂童長」 scheme has been launched since 2020 in Shum Shui Po to provide after school activities to low income families, to enrich their horizon and enhance children self-esteem.

He/She is responsible to recruit service users in the project in Shum Shui Po district, and to organize a parent-kid outdoor mass programme, with the following working tasks

- Organize a parent-kid mass activity in Shum Shui Po District, and recruit service users to build up positive parent-kid relationship; to apply positive parenting model, to promote a harmonious parent-child relationship and children's healthy development.
- Assist to organize an online graduation ceremony for children
- Prepare comprehensive records of all programme organized during the placement for future reference.

Student B (Elderly Service) (Shum Shui Po)

The “Networking for Health” scheme has been launched since 2020 to enhance the “Body-Mind-Spirit” health of elders in the Tai Hang Tung & Nam Shan district. Moreover, residents will be organized to establish a neighbourhood mutual support network for elders.

He/She is responsible to organize an elderly mutual aid group in the community, with the following working tasks:

- Organize and mobilise participants to join a mutual aid group with the aims to enhancing their knowledge on disease prevention and establishing a mutual support network.
- Prepare comprehensive records of the programmes organized during the placement for future references.

- Coordinate with the other staff and placement students to create and support the services under the project.

Student C (Sub-divided Unit Service) (Wong Tai Sin / Kowloon City)

The Community Care Fund rolled out the Assistance Programme to Improve the Living Environment of Low-income Subdivided Unit Households starting from June 20. It aims at improving the living environment of low-income households living in subdivided units (SDUs), and strengthening their connection with community services/resources.

He/She is responsible to:

- Follow-up furniture and electronic devices applications, conduct home visits for sub-divided unit tenants living in Wong Tai Sin and Kowloon City District;
- Organize summer activity for children and families living in sub-divided units;
- Raise tenants' awareness on the policies related to subdivided units (e.g. tenancy control issue)
