Dr WH Fok is a veteran civil and structural engineer who played significant role in mega-size infrastructure projects in Asia. Some of these projects are the Tsing Ma Bridge, Ngong Shuen Chau and Tsing Yi elevated highways, South Luzon Superhighway, Singapore MRT, Chongqing Toll Bridge and Tunnel, Shenzhen MRT and Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Zhuhai Superhighway. He has also been studying and reviewing construction-related government policies and practices as well as industry-wide issues, such as cost and schedule overruns. He is now doing consultancies on planning and implementation strategy of infrastructure projects.

Alongside with his career, he spends substantial time at universities teaching, supervising researches, designing and running of courses, and actively involving in university governance. He brings industry knowledge to universities and promotes new research findings to practical industry applications. He is currently an Adjunct Professor of the City University of Hong Kong and a Member of the Council and the Court of the Lingnan University.

He is a Master of Science, a Master of Arts and an Engineering Doctor. He is also a Fellow of six reputable qualifying professional institutions in the fields of civil engineering, structural engineering, highways and transportation, and dispute resolution.
