<sup>#</sup> Under the revamped English Language Enhancement (ELE) programme, students will be grouped under two streams. Group A students are those who obtained level 3 in HKDSE English or equivalent while Group B students are those who obtained level 4 or above in HKDSE English or equivalent. Students are encouraged to take their first required ELE course, viz. LUE1001 for Group A and LUE1002 for Group B, in First Term of Year 1. However, they are given the flexibility to take the respective courses in Second Term of Year 1. For Group A students who take LUE1001 in Second Term of Year 1, they should take LUE1002 in First Term of Year 2. For students directly admitted to Year 2 or Year 3, the six required courses will be assigned in their first and second year of studies at Lingnan with necessary adjustments.

### 1) Choices of Concentration

All Year 2 students of VS major are required to prioritise their choices of concentration in early December. Students can choose programme electives from two concentrations: Art History *or* Film Art.

## 2) Course Selection and Requirements

VS majors should take a minimum of 5 courses (15 credits) on the History and Theory of Visual Arts listed under one of the concentrations. The capstone project to be carried out in the final year is compulsory. For the remaining 9 credits, students can take courses listed under Categories I, II or III
