Job description

- Plan and execute project activities, assist in daily centre/project operation;

Key Responsibilities & Assigned Mini Mission

A. Children and Family Service (Shum Shui Po)

He/She is responsible to:

- Organize a parent or child mass activity in Shum Shui Po District to relief parent's pressure in child caring;
- Assist operation of child care centre aged 3-6;
- Plan and execute summer activities;

B. Community Service (Wong Tai Sin & Tsz Wan Shan)

He/She is responsible to:

- Plan and execute a volunteer training group, recruit child caregivers to participate the group, organize home visits to the elderly ; or,
- Plan and execute an environmental workshop, recruit child caregivers to participate the group;
- Organize summer activities for children and child caregivers (parallel activities are welcomed);
- Organize programmes to enhance the participation of elders and families in the community, such as elderly visits or mobile phone class.

C. Community Service (To Kwa Wan District)

He/She is responsible to:

- Plan and organize summer activity for children and families living in sub-divided units;
- Assist in recycle and waste charging scheme promotion activity in public housing and sub-divided unit area;
