

Staff-Student Consultation Committee (SSCC)

The SSCC provides a platform for students to express their views on the programme and individual courses, and for the departments/academic units to solicit student feedbacks on specific aspects of the programme and courses for continuous improvement.

The terms of reference are as follows.

1. To promote understanding between students and teaching staff;
2. To consider feedback from students regarding teaching, learning and course evaluation and issues of importance for enhancing teaching and learning quality;
3. To consider any other matters of concern to students;
4. To review and monitor the learning and teaching quality assurance mechanisms and processes within the programme;
5. To provide feedback to students on changes made to courses and teaching in response to the Course Teaching and Learning Evaluation exercise; and
6. To formulate strategies in helping students to learn more effectively.

Membership

Chairperson: DBA in GDEG Programme Director.

Members: Chairman of the Faculty's RPSC Sub-Committee, at least two staff members teaching for the programme in the current academic year and at least three student representatives.

Secretary: To be appointed by the Chairperson.
