PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Accelerated Dual B.S./M.S. Degree Option

To attract high-achieving and high potential international students, the RBS 3+2 program partners with highly selective universities from abroad to offer an accelerated dual-degree program. Students successfully completing the program receive a bachelor's degree from their home institution and a special master's degree in a business-related field from the Rutgers Business School in five years or less.

Students interested in the accelerated dual-degree option apply to the program in the third year of their undergraduate degree studies. Students who have completed most of the required coursework for their bachelor's degree (generally no more than nine credits remaining) will be admitted as full-time graduate students at Rutgers and can start taking graduate classes immediately upon arrival at Rutgers in the fourth year. The graduation requirements for both the undergraduate degree from the home university and the graduate degree from Rutgers will be completed concurrently in the final two years at RBS.

Visiting Student (Non-Degree) Option

The 3+2 program can also be used by qualified students who are not yet ready to commit themselves to graduate studies but would like to gain international experience by visiting Rutgers for one or more semesters. Visiting undergraduate students may take a course load of up to five courses per regular semester; one of these courses may be a graduate course. Students should get all courses pre-approved by their university's academic advisor so as to make sure that course credit earned at Rutgers will count toward the bachelor's degree of their home institution.





PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Choose between a non-degree (visiting student) and a dual degree (accelerated dual B.S./M.S. degree) option
- Take up to five courses of your choice per regular semester (non-degree option)
- Finish a bachelor's and a master's degree in 5 years or less (accelerated dual degree option)
- Customize your study plan according to your needs and interests
- Connect with a personal academic advisor
- Join the Summer Intensive Business English (SIBE) training program (mandatory for candidates of MFINA program)
- Enjoy the rich cultural life of the university and the larger New Brunswick community
- Make day trips to New York City, Philadelphia, or Washington, D.C.

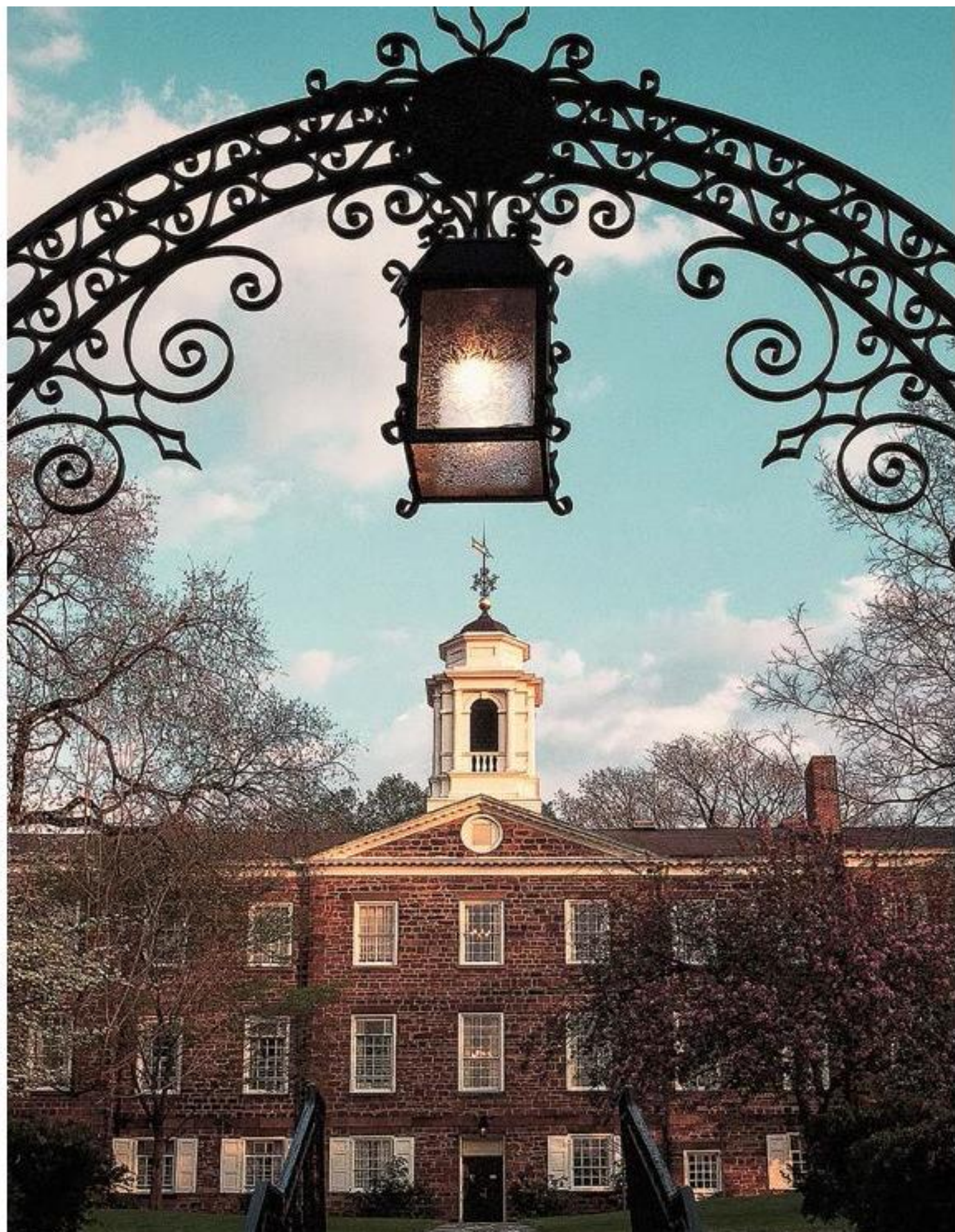

In addition to tuition, students also pay a Student fee (\$870.50/semester), School fee (\$529/semester), Technology fee (\$196.50/semester), Health Services Fee (\$250), Student Health Insurance Plan (\$1,146 for Fall; \$1,595 for Spring/Summer), and international student SEVIS fee (\$250.00/semester).

³ GMAT/GRE: R = Required; W = for students with an exceptional background, the GMAT/GRE requirement may be waived at the discretion of the program directors.

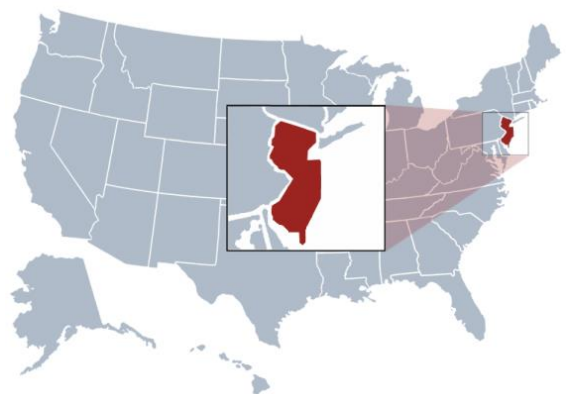
LIVING IN NEW JERSEY

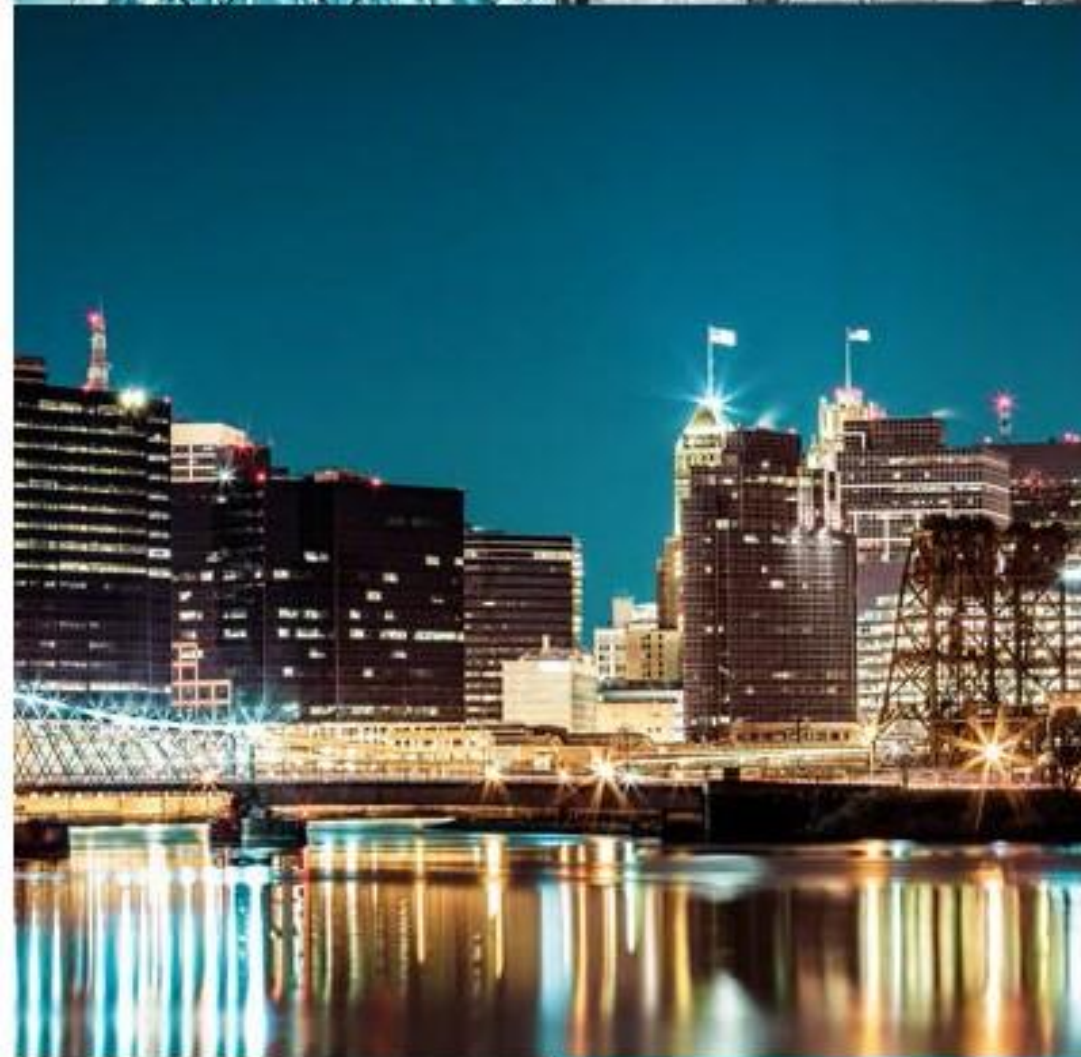


New Jersey is in the Northeastern region of the United States. It is the second-wealthiest U.S. state by median household income as of 2018.

ADMISSION PROCESS

A. ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ To be considered for the 3+2 program, students need to complete most of the required credits for their undergraduate degree in the first three years (generally no more than 9 credits remaining). Students who have more than 9 credits or 3 courses remaining should consider the non-degree (visiting student) option.
- ✓ Cumulative grade point average (GPA): at least **3.0 out of 4.0** or rank among the **top 30%** of their school, by the time of their enrollment at Rutgers.
- ✓ Satisfy the minimum English language proficiency requirements for acceptance into graduate programs at Rutgers University: **IBT TOEFL $\geq$ 90** for dual degree option; **79+** for visiting student option; **or IELTS $\geq$ 6.5** for both program options. Please note that a higher score will improve your chance of admission and are required for some master's programs.
- ✓ GMAT $\geq$ **600**. Students with an **exceptional** background may waive the GMAT requirement **at the discretion of the Program Directors**. (This requirement applies to the dual degree option only.)

B. PRE-APPLICATION

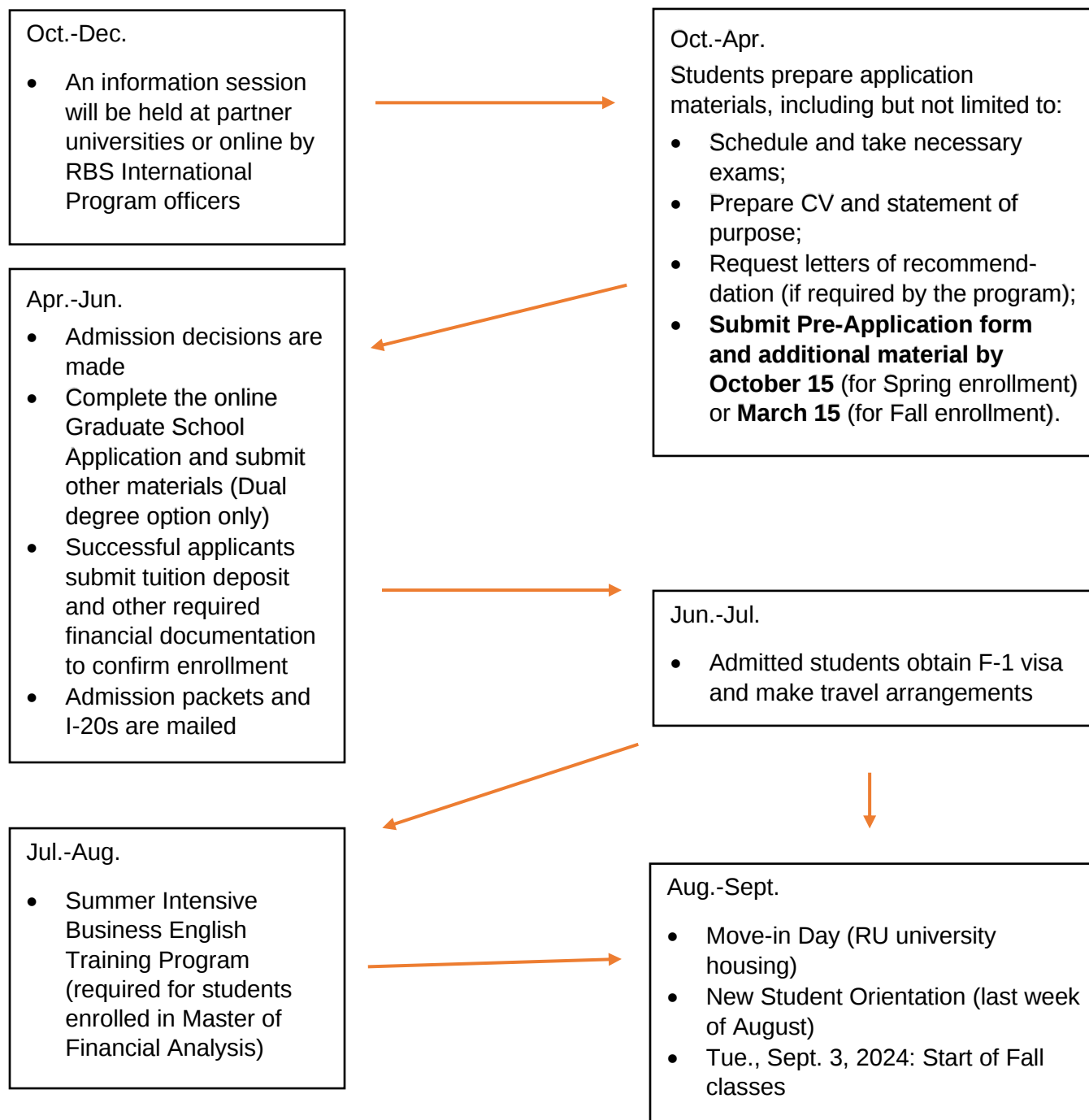
- ✓ Eligible students must be nominated by their home university and submit a pre-application form and all relevant material by October 15 (for Spring enrollment) or March 15 (for Fall enrollment).
- ✓ Pre-application is free of charge.
- ✓ In addition to the pre-application form, students submit a statement of purpose, CV, undergraduate transcript, test scores, and a study plan (for visiting student option only).

C. ONLINE APPLICATION

- ✓ Students who are accepted into the dual degree program will be asked to complete an online graduate school application and pay the regular application fee of \$70. Official test scores and letters of recommendation (if required by the program) will have to be sent directly to Graduate Admissions.

Student Visa

International students are required to obtain an appropriate visa (i.e., F-1) before traveling to the United States. Students should initiate the visa procedures immediately after accepting the offer.

Post-arrival

Students should plan to arrive in NJ and on campus at least one day before the international student orientation to set up their new home, open a bank account, sign up for a U.S. cell phone plan, purchase textbooks, etc.

Health Insurance

All international students are required to purchase health insurance at a level equivalent to or greater than the coverage required at Rutgers upon arrival.

SIBE (Intensive Business English)

International students are strongly recommended to attend our Summer Intensive Business English training program to improve their English language and presentation skills. SIBE tuition is separate from the graduate tuition. (Mandatory for students accepted to the Master of Financial Analysis program.)

Maintaining Academic Standing

Students should maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 for graduation (dual degree option only). A student who receives more than two C grades or more than one F grade will be dismissed for failure to maintain satisfactory grades.





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
