



Professor Roger YUEN

Professor Yuen is a seasoned banker with extensive expertise in China's financial sector. His deep understanding of the Chinese market and banking acumen led to his historic appointment in 1990 as the first General Manager of Citibank, N.A. in Shanghai – marking the return of foreign banking operations in China since 1949. Prior to this role, he served as Assistant General Manager [Finance] at China Resources [Holdings] Ltd. in Hong Kong. Concluding his distinguished 40-year career in banking and finance, Professor Yuen was Head of China and Taiwan Private Banking at The Bank of East Asia. He currently serves as an Adjunct Professor at Lingnan University.

Beyond his professional achievements, Professor Yuen is deeply engaged in community service, with a 48-year commitment to various leadership roles. These include:

- Member, Advisory Board on Business Studies, and former Council Member of Lingnan University;
- Former Council Member, Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications;
- Member, Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference [Shanghai Committee];
- Vice President, Hong Kong Society of Economists;
- Chairman, Advisory Committee of the Overseas Graduates Association;
- President, J S Group of Hong Kong.

In recognition of his outstanding contributions to business and society, he was honored with the Award of Distinction by Concordia University [1998] and named an Honorary Fellow by Lingnan University [2017]. Professor Yuen holds a Bachelor's degree and an MBA from Concordia University in Montreal, Canada.
