

Minor in Risk and Insurance Management

The Business Programmes Office coordinates the offering of the Minor in Risk and Insurance Management. This Minor programme is open to both BBA and non-BBA students, except for Risk and Insurance Management stream students.

Students are required to complete 15 credits of courses in total. In addition to taking the required courses listed below, students must select three electives listed below.

Required Courses (*6 credits*)

RIM2200 Principles of Risk Management

RIM2201 Principles of Insurance

Elective Courses (*9 credits*)

Either

9 credits from any 2000- to 4000-level Risk and Insurance Management courses (RIM-coded)

Or

6 credits from any 2000- to 4000-level Risk and Insurance Management courses (RIM-coded) **plus** one of the following relevant courses:

FIN2300 Investment and Portfolio Management

FIN3353 Management of Financial Institutions

FIN3356 Fixed Income Securities
