The Board of Examiners makes decisions on examinations, continuous assessment and recommendation of students for graduation/special consideration.

The Terms of reference of the BoE are:

1. To maintain the academic standards of the programme;
2. To maintain general supervision of the system of continuous assessment;
3. To assess the performance of students in the programme;
4. To maintain the proper conduct of examinations;
5. To approve the final examination results;
6. To make recommendations of students for graduation;
7. To deal with grievances and appeals from students; and
8. To report to the Research and Postgraduate Studies Committee of the Senate.
