

Programme and Curriculum Committee

The PCC serves to monitor and assure the satisfactory operation of the programme. The PCC reports to the Department Board and to the PSC.

The Terms of reference of the PCC are:

1. To take charge of the degree programme, including the design, implementation and review of the curriculum, inter alia, the achievement of the intended student learning outcomes.
2. To liaise with all departments/centres concerned on programme matters, such as course offerings for each academic year.
3. To liaise with the Registry/School of Graduate Studies (GS) on all academic matters, including review of academic regulations and examination matters (if their Boards of Examiners are subsumed into their PCCs)
4. To review the admissions policy for the programme
5. To deal with all other matters related to the programme.
