Irene Ng Wai-ming



The incumbent Director of Student Affairs of Lingnan University responsible for the provision of a comprehensive suite of activities, services and support to nurture students' holistic development, Irene Ng Wai-ming is a seasoned professional in the higher education sector with extensive administrative and managerial expertise. Prior to joining Lingnan University, Irene was engaged as a full-time staff in various industries namely Metro Broadcast Corporation Limited, Jockey Club Rehabilitation Complex of Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, and The Chinese University of Hong Kong. The clientele and partners with whom she has frequently collaborated range from media practitioners, event planners, showbiz personalities, people with diverse disabilities, social welfare personnel, menial workers, government officials, entrepreneurs, professoriate to students.

Irene received her BA and MEd degrees in the 1990s in Hong Kong and has been titled Certified Facilitator in Student Leadership Challenge[®] since 2013. She is currently Trustee of the Dr. Ng Tat-lun Memorial Scholarship Fund which has, so far, benefited outstanding and/or needy students of the Vocational Training Council, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, and Lingnan University. Irene had also been elected as ExCom Member of the Chinese Executives Club (under Hong Kong Management Association) for several sessions and is currently Members of various committees of the Chinese YMCA of Hong Kong including, inter alia, the "Be a Global Citizen Campaign" Steering Group chaired by Mr. Andy Tsang Wai-hung.

During her tenure in The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Irene led the office under her helm to win the Team Award under the “Positive Workplace Service Awards Scheme” in two consecutive sessions. She also received the Individual Award in 2021. To continue working for the next generation, Irene wishes to take part in the higher-level businesses of Lingnan University such as formulating strategic directions through not only her position as the Director of Student Affairs but also her involvement in its supreme governing body - the Council. 伍慧明在高等教育界擁有豐富的行政及管理經驗，現為嶺南大學學生事務處處長，負責向學生提供多方位活動、服務及支援，以培養他們的全面發展。伍氏加入嶺南大學前，全職受僱於不同行業，計有新城廣播有限公司、東華三院賽馬會復康中心及香港中文大學；其服務對象與合作夥伴包括媒體從業員、活動策劃人、演藝工作者、有不同能力障礙人士、社會福利人員、前線職工、政府官員、企業家、教授和學生。

伍氏於 90 年代在香港獲得文學士和教育碩士學位，並於 2013 年獲認證為 Student Leadership Challenge® 促導員。她目前是伍達倫博士紀念獎學基金的信託人，該基金迄今資助來自職業訓練局、香港理工大學、香港中文大學及嶺南大學的優秀及 / 或有需要學生。此外，伍氏多度當選香港管理專業協會工商管理研究社的執行委員，現時擔任香港中華基督教青年會轄下不同委員會成員，例如由曾偉雄先生主持的「世界公民」導向工作小組。
