Terms of Reference

The Sustainability Steering Committee is responsible for overseeing and advancing the university's sustainability efforts in alignment with global best practices. The Committee's key responsibilities include:

- a) To ensure the university's strategies, policies, and initiatives are aligned with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- b) To formulate, review, and implement comprehensive sustainability policies to guide the university's operations and practices.
- c) To plan and manage sustainability-focused projects and initiatives to ensure their effective execution and impact.
- d) To enhance and promote awareness and engagement in sustainability among students, faculty and staff.

Members	:	Vice-President (Academics) cum Provost (Ex-officio) Up to 7 members* (academic and non-academic staff focused on sustainability)
Secretary	:	A staff member of the Office of the President

** The Chairperson is authorized to appoint up to seven members to the Sustainability Steering Committee.*
