Vincent Woo Distinguished Visiting Scholars Programme

(a) Objectives

The Lingnan University Vincent Woo Distinguished Visiting Scholars Programme is intended to invite distinguished non-local scholars to visit the University for a short period of up to one week to give a public lecture and to engage in other scholarly pursuits. Under this Programme, two scholars, one from Asia and the other from Europe or America, will be invited to the University every year.

(b) Invitation

As a liberal arts institution, the University will invite internationally renowned scholars in the fields related to the current or future development of the University.

(c) Activities

The Vincent Woo Distinguished Visiting Scholar will be invited to give at least one public lecture in the University (or another venue as deemed appropriate), to hold other seminars and talks, to meet with staff and students and to give advice to the University.

(d) Terms

The terms of the visits will include:

- (i) business class return air passage for self, or economy class return air passage for self and spouse accompanying the scholar for the visit to the University;
- (ii) hotel or University accommodation for the duration of the visit for self and where appropriate, accompanying spouse; and
- (iii) an allowance for daily expenses, viz. HK\$300 per day for the duration of the visit and US\$1,000 for the visit.
