Description	- IMC (Australian National Institute of Management and Commerce), the trading name of Top Education Group Ltd (listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange), has grown since its founding in the early 2000s into one of Australia's leading private Institutes of Higher Education. - IMC holds Self-Accrediting Authority (SAA) status from TEQSA in the field of Management and Commerce (AQF levels 5–9) , one of only a small number of institutions in Australia to hold this status. IMC has three campuses, Sydney (NSW), Hobart (TAS) and Perth (WA); each centrally located with easy transport access, dedicated student support services and a vibrant, welcoming study environment. - Our Sydney campus sits in the heritage-listed South Eveleigh precinct close to the CBD.

Insurance (OSHC):	Overseas Student Health Cover is mandatory for all international students. Cover can be purchased through IMC or arranged independently with an approved provider.
Living Costs (3-month indicative):	Per the Department of Home Affairs / Study Australia, the national indicative minimum is approx. AUD \$7,428 for 3 months. By campus: Sydney (NSW) approx. AUD \$7,800–12,600; Hobart (TAS) approx. AUD \$5,200–5,400, the most affordable of the three; Perth (WA) approx. AUD \$5,800. IMC's own indicative 3-Month Living Allowance of AUD \$8,000/person applies uniformly across all three campuses, comfortably above the national guideline.
